Governance – This show is operated in accordance with the current rules of the Ohio Hunter/Jumper Association (OHJA), Mid-Ohio Dressage Association (MODA), and Ohio Dressage Society (ODS).

Entries (Dressage) – Dressage entries must register online at equinelive.com on or before the Monday prior to the start date of each show. Entries received after closing date will be considered post entry, may not be accepted, and may incur late fees.

Entries (Hunter / Jumper) – Hunter / Jumper entries must register online at equineline.com prior to the show.

Dressage Ride Times – Provisional times will be available to competitors the Wednesday prior to the date of each show.

Hazardous Weather / Act of God / Accident Policy – Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. Refunds for such acts will be at management's discretion.

Helmets - ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by all persons on horseback at all times.

Stabling / Bedding – Stalls are available starting Friday at 3:00 pm and must be vacated Sunday evening. Stall assignments will be made available to competitors the Thursday prior to the show.

Payment – All major credit cards and checks are accepted. Checks may be made out of "Happily Ever After". Entries must be paid in full to receive an exhibitor number unless a blank check or credit card information is left on file. Due to current COVID-19 restrictions, if paying with cash, only exact change will be accepted.

Arenas –

Ring 1 – 35M x 80M arena with sand footing mix.

Ring 2 – 35M x 70M arena with sand footing mix.

Ring 3 – 30M x 70M arena with sand footing mix.

Dressage – All tests will be ridden in one standard 20M x 60M arena with sand footing mix. The setup will comply with Dressage Level 1 class rules. Some tests may be ridden in a small dressage arena 20M x 40M.

Schooling – Schooling is permitted in the show rings Friday starting at 3:00pm and after the show each day. No schooling in the show ring will be allowed during the show. Dedicated warmup areas are available throughout the day.

Exhibitor number is required to school.

Show Office – Show Office Hours:

Sunday: 7:30 am to 30 minutes after show concludes

Ribbons – Ribbons awarded to 1st through 6th place for all classes, unless otherwise noted in class description. Dressage Open, Adult Amateur, and Junior and Young Rider divisions will be pinned separately. Placings and ribbons will be available for pickup in the pavilion between Ring 1 and Ring 2.

Drag / Lunch Breaks – Periodic drag and watering breaks for show rings and warmup areas will be taken throughout the day as deemed necessary by show management. Lunch break will be determined on the day of the show by show management.

Dogs – For the safety and courtesy of all exhibitors and spectators, all dogs must at all times be on a leash and under the control of a handler, or suitably restrained in a tack stall or similar.

Eligibility

Rider's Age – The age of an individual on December 1 shall be maintained throughout the entire show year.

HEASS Eligibility – All horses and riders automatically accumulate points towards HEASS year-end awards.

OHJA Eligibility – This show is operated in accordance with the current rules of the Ohio Hunter/Jumper Association. To be eligible for the Annual High Score Awards, the exhibitor and the owner must be members, and the horse or pony must be registered with the Association. Applications may be obtained from the Show Secretary in the Show Office. Exhibitors can also join online or by mail. See OHJA's website (ohja.org) for more information.

MODA Eligibility – Exhibitors must be MODA members to be eligible for MODA year-end awards. See MODA's website (midohiodressage.com) for more information on membership and year-end award eligibility.

ODS Eligibility – Exhibitors must be ODS members to be eligible for ODS year-end awards. See ODS's website (ohiodressagesociety.com) for more information on membership and year-end award eligibility.

Class Specifications

Leadline

Open to riders 8 years of age and under who have never show in W/T or higher.

Mini Stirrup W/T - HEASS

Open to riders 11 years of age and under who have never shown over fences or in a class requiring them to canter.

Hunter Breeding - HEASS

To be judged on conformation, quality, substance and suitability to become or produce hunters. If entries warrant, class may be split into three years and under and four years and older. To be shown in hand at the walk and trot.

Unrestricted W/T Poles - HEASS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and way of going.

Unrestricted Crossrails - HEASS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and way of going.

Thoroughbred Crossrails – HEASS, TIP

Open to Thoroughbreds by riders of all ages and any experience. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and way of going.

Baby Hunter 18" - HEASS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Trotting in corners is not penalized. Fence height 18".

Future Hunter 18" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to riders of any age or beginner horses or ponies that have never shown above 2'0". Fence height 18".

Beginner Hunter 2' - HEASS

Open to riders of any age or horses/ponies that have never shown over 2'6" or higher. Fence height 2'0".

Very Low Non-Pro Hunter 2' - HEASS, OHJA

Open to all horses and riders except for professionals. Fence height 2'0".

Thoroughbred Very Green Hunter 2' - HEASS, TIP

Open to Thoroughbreds and riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 2'0".

Very Green Hunter 2'3" - HEASS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 2'3".

Short Stirrup Hunter 2'3" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior exhibitors eleven years of age and under. Limited to riders who have never shown over fences 2'6" or higher or in any pony hunter/jumper division. Fence height 2'3".

Limit Rider Hunter 2'3" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by exhibitors twelve years of age and over. Limited to riders who have never shown over fences 2'6" or higher or in any pony hunter/jumper division. Fence height 2'3".

Special Hunter 2'6" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 2'6".

Baby Green Hunter 2'6" - HEASS, OHJA

A Baby Green Hunter is a horse or pony of any age in its first or second year of showing at 2'6", and has never competed over fences higher than 2'6". A horse is eligible for the OHJA year-end awards for either or both of two consecutive years. Once a horse has shown in the Pre-Green Hunter division, it may no longer compete in the Baby Green Hunter division. Fence height 2'6".

Intermediate Adult / Child Hunter 2'6" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders who are considered amateurs or junior riders according to USEF rules. Riders may not cross-enter at the same show into any class/section where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception: 3'0" Equitation). Fence height 2'6".

Low Hunter 3' - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 3'0".

Thoroughbred Schooling Jumper 3'0" - HEASS, TIP

Open to Thoroughbreds and riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 3'0".

W/T Poles Equitation - HEASS, OHJA

Open to riders of any age who have never shown over fences or in a class requiring them to canter (except Cross-Rail Equitation). Ground pole trotting is permitted.

Crossrails Equitation - HEASS, OHJA

Open to riders of any age who have not shown at a canter over a course of fences 18" or higher. Trotting is not penalized. Canter is permitted on the flat in small groups (five or less) only. Showing in this division does not affect a rider's eligibility for Walk/Trot Equitation. Riders may cross enter into Future Hunters.

Equitation 18" - HEASS

Open to riders who have never shown over a course of fences 2'6" or higher. Trotting in corners is not penalized. Fence height 18".

Short Stirrup Equitation 2'3" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior exhibitors eleven years of age and under. Limited to riders who have never shown over fences 2'6" or higher or in any pony hunter/jumper division. Fence height 2'3", no combinations.

Limit Rider Equitation 2'3" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by exhibitors twelve years of age and over. Limited to riders who have never shown over fences 2'6" or higher or in any pony hunter/jumper division. Fence height 2'3", no combinations.

Intermediate Adult / Child Equitation 2'6" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to riders eligible for the Intermediate Adult / Child Hunter Division. Fence height 2'6".

Beginner Jumpers 2' - HEASS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 2', or 0.61m, no combinations.

Hopeful Jumpers 2'3" - HEASS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 2'3" or 0.69m, no combinations.

Intermediate Adult / Child Jumper 2'6" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders who are considered amateurs or junior riders according to USEF rules. Fence height 2'6" or 0.77m.

Thoroughbred Special Hunter 2'6" - HEASS, TIP

Open to Thoroughbreds ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 2'6".

Schooling / Training Jumper 3'0" - HEASS, OHJA

Open to horses and ponies. Fence height 3'0" or 0.91m.

Gamblers' Choice

Each jump on course has an assigned point value and may be jumped a maximum of two (2) times. If a jump falls, the points for that jump do not count and it may not be jumped a second time. Should a refusal occur, no penalty is incurred. At the end of the allowed time a tone will sound. If the horse has left the ground when the tone sounds, that jump will count provided it remains up. The rider then must cross the "finish" line. At this time the Joker fence may optionally be attempted once. It is worth 200 points, but if the rail falls, 200 points will be deducted from the total. The Joker fence may be set up to 12" higher than the course height. Offered at 2'0", 2'3", 2'6" and 3'0" and judged together.

Hunter Derby

Offered at 2'0", 2'3", 2'6" and 3'0" and judged together. Two-round format with the first round to be classic hunter course and the second round to include "handy"-type course. Both scores will be combined to determine placings. Questions may include, but are not limited to, halt on course, trot fence, roll back, negotiating natural obstacles, etc.

Thoroughbred Hunter Classic – TIP

Open to Thoroughbred by riders of all ages and any experience. – Offered at 2'0", 2'3", 2'6" and 3'0" and judged together. Two-round format with the first round to be classic hunter course and the second round to include "handy"-type course. Both scores will be combined to determine placings. Questions may include, but are not limited to, halt on course, trot fence, roll back, negotiating natural obstacles, etc.

OHJA Medal - OHJA

Two phase class to be shown first over a course consisting of a minimum of eight (8) fences, with two (2) changes of direction. A minimum of twelve (12) riders, if available, will be required to show at a walk, trot and canter following the jumping phase. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse. Each phase of the class (over fences and on the flat) shall count fifty (50) percent. A minimum of three (3) competitors must complete the course and ride on flat in order for the class to fill. Once the first exhibitor has competed over fences in the class no additional entries to that class are allowed. Fence height varies with the rider's age/ability.

Crossrail Classic

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Rider/Horse combinations must have entered into at least one class in Ring 3 on Saturday at the same show. Rider/Horse combination may not enter cross-enter into any class where the fences are greater than 18" at the same show.

Jumper Stake

Open to riders who have shown in at least one jumper division at the same show. Offered at 2'0", 2'3", 2'6" and 3'0" and judged together.
