

**Happily Ever After Show Series
COVID19 Policy**

****All participants must review and adhere to the below policy****
No entry will be accepted without signed policy

Managing your risk of exposure to the Coronavirus is essential to maintaining good health. At this time, it is appropriate to be cognizant of proper hygiene and incorporating common sense actions into your everyday activities in order to prevent the spread of this virus. Practices such as regularly washing your hands with soap and water or an alcohol based hand sanitizer; practicing good sneeze and cough hygiene; avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with unwashed hands; avoiding close contact with people who are sick; and disinfecting and cleaning often touched objects and surfaces can help reduce your risk of exposure.

Participants includes owners, lessees, riders, parents, trainers, coaches, and grooms.

Participants are required to self-monitor their temperature daily prior to entering the competition grounds. Anyone with a temperature below 99.5° F (37.5° C) may enter the facility. Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks, cannot enter the competition grounds.

Facemasks or face covering are strongly recommended when not mounted on a horse. **A participant may choose to wear a facemask or face covering when mounted on a horse and cannot be disqualified or penalized for doing so while competing.

Participants should comply with social distancing requirements at all times while on the competition grounds.

- Avoid congregate settings or concentration of individuals in a single area and maintaining a minimum of six feet from others unless absolutely impossible.
- Wash hands often and use other sanitization practices throughout the day. Competition office will have limited/restricted access to essential personnel only,

All competitors are to complete entry forms, in their entirety, prior to entering competition office. All adds, scratches, and other questions will be required to be communicated to show office electronically.
